



Spectator Information

18th – 19th June 2010

The Rally of the Midlands is again sponsored by Trinity Hyundai of Hinckley and we are grateful for their continued and enthusiastic support of the event.

The event is a round of four championships: Richard Egger Insurance MSA Asphalt Rally Championship incorporating the BTRDA Asphalt Rally Challenge; AWMCM Heart of England Rally Championship; ANCC Stage Rally Championship; and the Historic Stage Rally Challenge incorporating the Mini Cup. The entry includes a number of World Rally Cars and an array of impressive clubmen vehicles including plenty of Ford Escorts.

Scrutineering (MR 140/409933)

This will take place on the site of Trinity Motors at the rear of the building. Spectators are welcome but please park at the rear of the site behind the Waterside Public House and Premier Inn to allow plenty of room for rally crews manoeuvring vehicles around.

Rally HQ and Service area

There is a central service area at Greene King Stadium, home of Hinckley United Football Club (MR 140/450960) which is open to the public during the weekend. Parking is in the adjoining Rugby Club for which a nominal charge may be made.

The rally cars will visit the venue on Friday evening about 20:00 and twice on Saturday at approximately 10:15 and 14:00.

A range of hot food and a licensed bar will be available throughout the weekend.

When visiting the service area, please stand back from crews servicing the cars and follow any marshals' instructions. Motorsport can be dangerous.

Stages

There are three exciting spectator venues throughout the weekend. The Argents Mead stage on Friday, taking place in front of the Council Offices in Hinckley, is free of charge. On the gate admission charges for Mallory Park are £3 per person on Friday and £6 on Saturday, with accompanied children under 16 admitted free.

On Friday and Saturday, admission charges for the stages at Bramcote Barracks near Nuneaton will be £5 per person per day. Please note that all children under 16 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

FRIDAY 18TH JUNE

The Official Start of the 2010 event will see the cars leaving from the pedestrian area outside The Civic Hall in the centre of Bedworth at 18:00 hrs. Cars will begin to assemble from 17:40 hrs and crews will be flagged away at minute intervals.

SS3 and SS4 – Bramcote Barracks near Nuneaton (MR 140/414884) – 18:45 hrs

£5 per person

Can be accessed via the B4114 out of Nuneaton towards Wolvey Heath. Take the right hand turn into Bazzard Road, drive past the main entrance to the Gamecock Barracks and look out for signs to turn right into the car park.

Spectators can view over half of the stage at this live Army Barracks. See the cars on this slippery tarmac surface pushed to the limit. This stage is run twice.

SS5 - Argents Mead (MR 140/429937) – 19:15 hrs

There will be plenty to see and do with free entry for all. Full commentary is provided and food wagons will be in attendance to satisfy your needs. Spectators will be allowed all around the stage which runs in front of the Council House. Please follow Marshals' directions and safety instructions and remain behind the barriers at all times.

The town centre public cars parks (except Mount Road & the Council Offices) will be open for spectators' use.

SS6 and SS7 – Mallory (MR 140/452006) – 19:30 hrs

£3 per person

Accompanied children under 16 FREE
Tickets available via the Mallory Park website or on the gate.

Mallory Park is situated in the village of Kirkby Mallory, just off the A47 between Leicester and Hinckley. Look for the brown tourism signs, including those which bring you direct from J21 of the M1.

See some fantastic high speed action.

Artificial chicanes, together with splits and merges have been added to increase the challenge. Using the circuit in an anti-clockwise direction, cars will also be traversing the centre of the circuit through the paddock area.

SATURDAY 19TH JUNE

SS11 and SS12– Mallory (MR 140/452006) – 09:45 hrs

£6 per person

Accompanied children under 16 FREE
Tickets available via the Mallory Park website or on the gate.

As above. This time, the stages are reversed from the previous day's run so see how the crews handle the challenges offered from this perspective.

SS13 and SS14 – Bramcote Barracks near Nuneaton (MR 140/414884) – 11:00 hrs

£5 per person

Spectators can view over half of the stage at this live Army Barracks. See the cars on this slippery tarmac surface pushed to the limit. Again, this stage is run twice.

SS16 and SS17– Mallory (MR 140/452006) – 12:45 hrs

SS18 and SS19 – Bramcote (MR 140/414884) – 14:00 hrs

£5 per person

This time the stages are reversed, again being run twice.

The finish of day two sees the cars arriving in the pedestrian area in Hinckley Town Centre at around 15:30 hrs for the Ceremonial Finish. Finishing crews will pass over the ramp where they will be greeted by the Mayor.

Please be aware that all times are approximate and subject to alteration.

Rally Radio is provided by Oak FM 107.9 will be broadcasting half hourly reports so please tune in for regular updates.

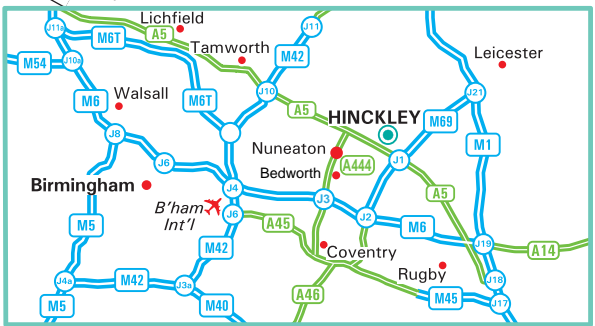

Enter the pedestrian area through the 'NO ENTRY' signs and proceed to the 'Pre-Start Holding Control'

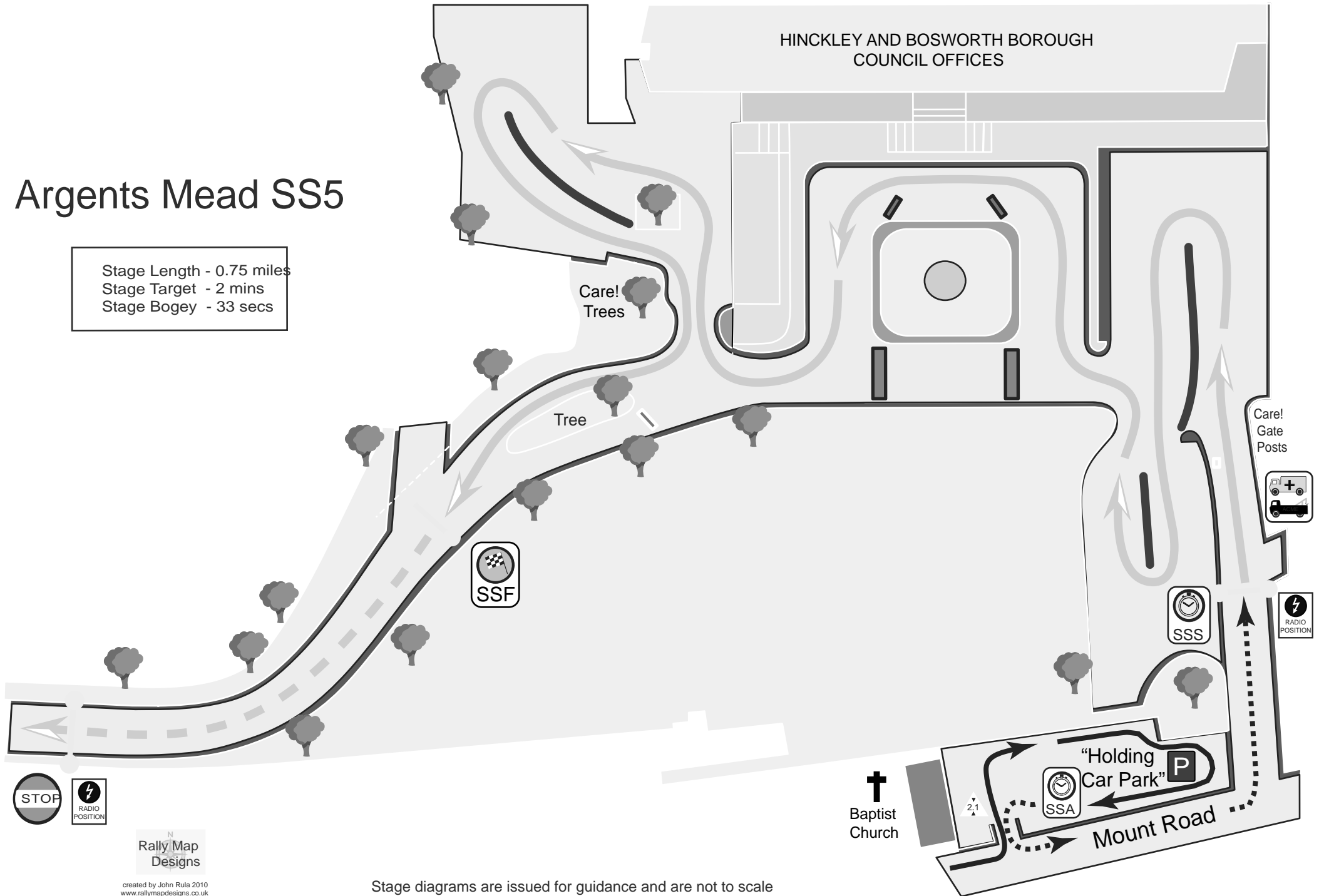
